The Cub Scout camping program starts on Thursday, July 15<sup>th</sup> and continues through August 18<sup>th</sup>. The work week for camp staff runs from Thursday at 8:30 AM through Monday at 6:00 PM. There is mandatory training the first weekend in June, with camp setup the week of June 14<sup>th</sup> (if available) and camp shutdown for several days following the last day for campers.
